Not all students are done as each painting (and artist) is very different. Second grade is really proud of their progress. We did a lot of research about leopards, their behavior and their habitat. Using images of leopards, we traced them then transfers the traced pieces onto a canvas. Now we are learning how to layer acrylic paint from dark to light in order to create depth.
